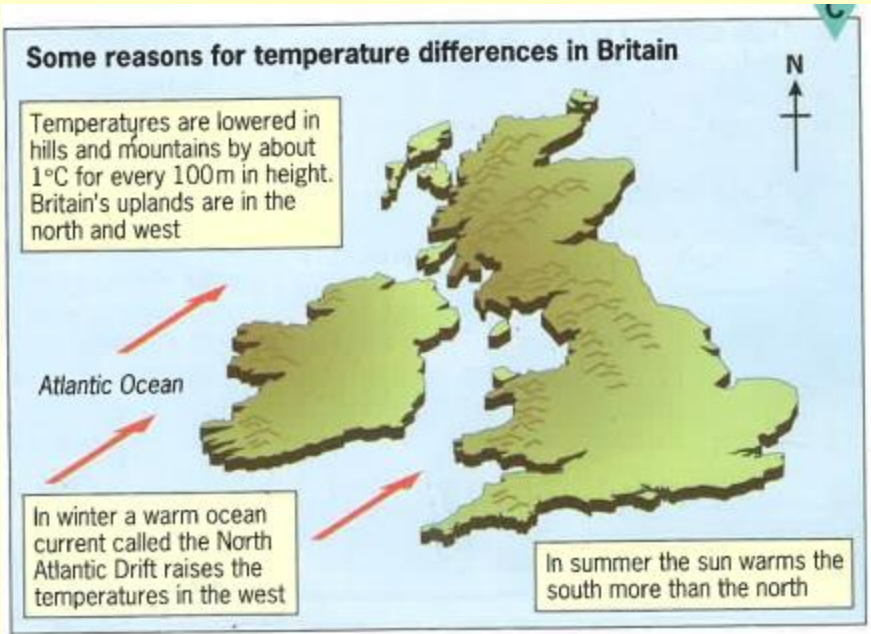
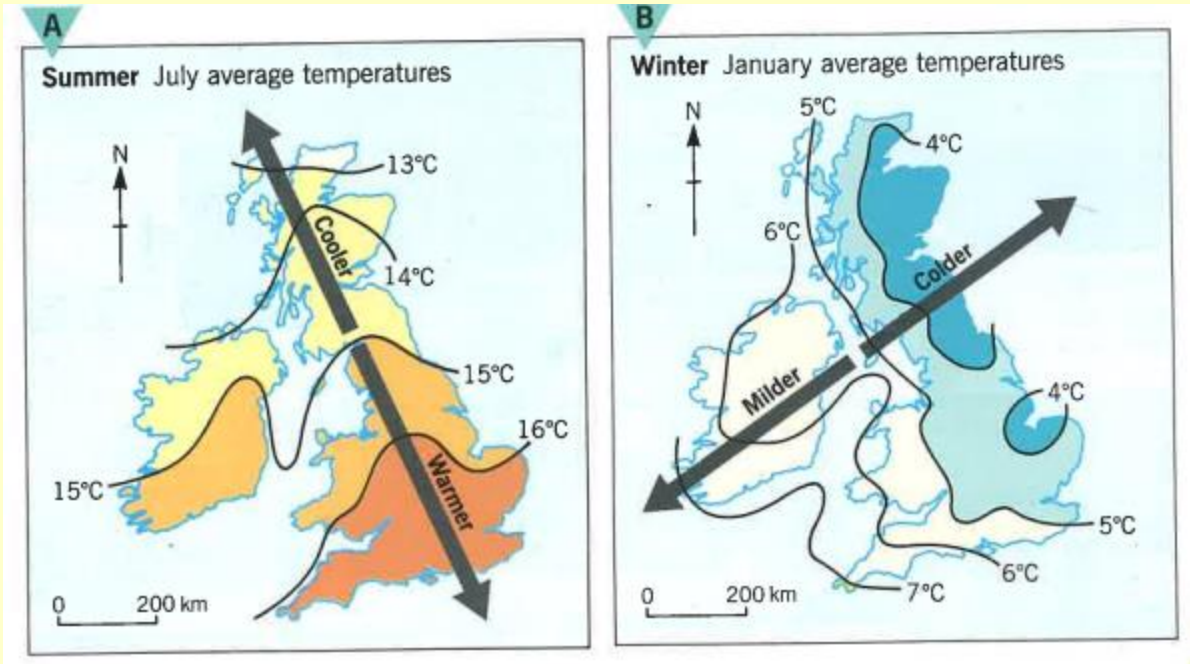


Key Term	Definition
Weather	The day to day conditions of the atmosphere e.g. sunny, cloudy, raining.
Climate	The average weather of a place. For example, in the U.K we have 4 seasons: Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter.
Precipitation	Water coming out of the sky as rain, snow, sleet or hail.
Microclimate	The climate of a small area such as the grounds of the school.
Aspect	The direction that something is facing.
Altitude	The height of the land above sea level.

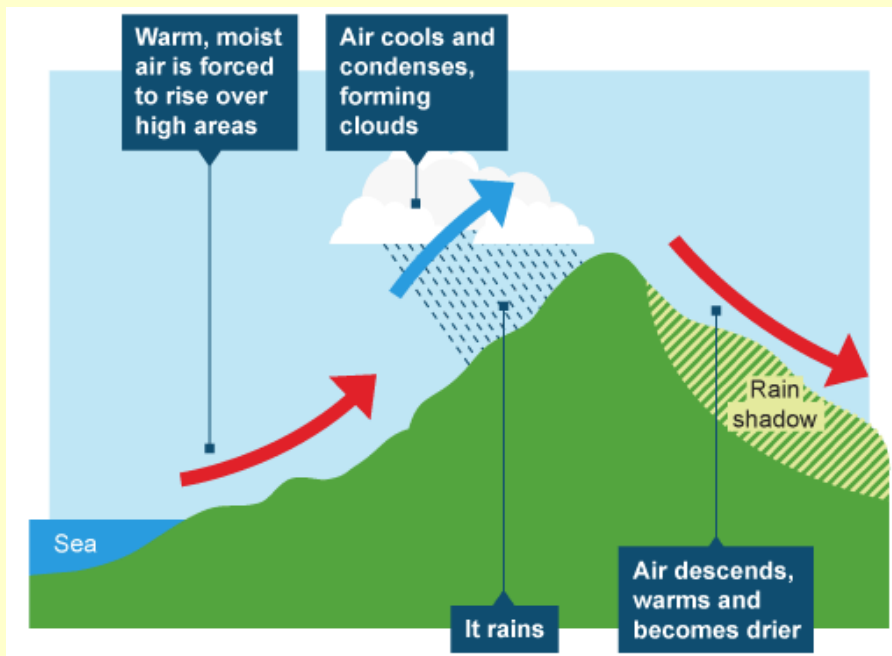
YEAR 7 KNOWLEDGE ORGANISER: Why does it always seem to rain in the U.K?



Summers in Britain are warmer than winters. The warmest temperatures are found in the south and it gets gradually warmer as we go north.
